- ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The Quad Riders Association of South Australia Inc, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the QuadridersSA ATV & SideCar 2017 MX Titles South Australian Championships at Loveday 4x4 Adventure Park, 1115 Caddy Road Barmera SA, on Saturday 15th July 2017 & Recreational Riding on 16th July.
- JURISDICTION:**
 - The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number **C17091** and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior National & Junior National Licences, except for Non-Comp/Demonstration classes which require a minimum One Event Recreation Licence.
 - The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.
- ENTRIES:**
 - Entries open forthwith and close last mail **Wednesday 12th July 2017. (If a minimum of 40 entries are not received by the date mentioned the the Promoter may cancel the event)**
 - In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Quadriders Association of South Australia if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
 - Only entries received on the official entry form that is **accompanied** by the correct fee will be accepted.
 - NOTE: - LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MOTOCROSS COORDINATOR AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE QUADRIDERS ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA.**
- INSURANCE:**
 - National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
 - Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

4.3 IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.

5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

St. Johns Ambulance will be present to provide Medical Services for the entire duration of practice and racing at the event.

9 **AWARDS:**

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd placegetters for competition classes following the completion of racing.

10 **ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**

10.1. To constitute a State Title Championship class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be **Six (6)**.

10.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prize money, will be at the discretion of the Quad Riders Association of South Australia Inc subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

Classes that proceed with fewer than the minimum number of contestants per 10.1, will not be eligible for a Championship Title.

10.3. The single senior ATV **Open** Championship class may be split into **Pro** and **Intermediate** Championship classes only if **Open** receives **15 entrants or more**, and where forming Pro and Intermediate classes will cause a minimum of 7 entrants for the smaller of the two classes. In the instance where the Promoter chooses to exercise this rule, Pro will run 15min +1lap, and Intermediate will run 12min+1lap duration. This will be decided on close of entries and best efforts will be made to inform entrants before race day "IF" creation of the two classes is decided. Otherwise the single Open class will be run as the normal.

11 **RACE FORMAT:**

- 11.1 There will be 4 rounds of racing for each competition class with each race scored from 1st place through to 20th place as per the MOMS, 35 point system. **One of the 4 rounds for each class will be a sprint round of 2 laps.** Any draw on points will be decided on count back.
- 11.2 **Practice** will consist of **3 laps** per class, the first lap of which being under yellow flag conditions of no jumping, no overtaking.
- 11.3 4 rounds of 3 /4 laps or timed races (refer 8. Classes of Competition)
- 11.4 FLAG MARSHALLS: Entrants/Family must supply 1 Flag Marshall for the Event, flag position roster will be announced at riders brief and displayed at event.

12 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for their class of competition and all relevant sections for competition.
- 12.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 12.3 Change of machine may be permitted up to 10 minutes prior to the start of the event which the substitute machine is required. Notice must be given, and approval gained by the Steward via the Clerk of the Course. The substitute machine must have passed at machine examination.
- 12.4 To participate in the event, it is the riders responsibility to present their machine at the designated scrutineering point and pass scrutineering for Competition classes or machine examination for Recreational classes.
- 12.5 Riders must display numberplates on their machine which comply with the 2017 GCR's.
- 12.6 To compete, all riders must have clearly visible numbers on his or her back that comply with the 2017 GCR's. NO BACK NUMBERS, NO POINTS.

13 GRID POSITIONS:

- 13.1 Grid positions will be allocated by a random peg draw at the start of 1st race and then as per finishing places for the remainder of the event (or other system as informed at riders briefing)
- 13.2 Maximum number of starters per race will be twenty (20)

14 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

- 14.1 A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions. **On completion of rider's briefing ALL riders & parents/guardians of Juniors must sign the attendance form – no signature = rider – no start.**
- 14.2 **Riders Brief will occur on the day of the Championship event prior to commencement of Practice.**
- 14.3 **Riders Practice: All Riders are required to attend at Practice.**

15 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 15.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 15.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, Tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.
- 15.3 For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be from Saturday the 27th of August 7:00am until 30 mins after the completion of the last race on Sunday, or as declared by the Steward.

16 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

18 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

- 18.1 The track consists of natural terrain and man-made jumps, rollers, drop-offs, bermed corners, straights and table tops.
- 18.2 Track length is 1500 metres and runs in an anti-clock-wise direction.

19 STARTS:

- 19.1 A starting light race control system will be used.
Normal starts will include 15 second arrangement, then 5 second arrangement before release (Start) within 1-5 seconds.
Any detected 'Rolling' may be considered a jump start with full grid restart with offending rider held back or other rider penalty.
A race restart will be held immediately after "RED light" with the penalising rider/s held back and released 5 seconds after the restart procedure.
(Penalised riders may have their starting position re-allocated on the grid at the starter's discretion).
Full details of starting arrangements will be clearly explained at the compulsory riders briefing.
Contingency for start lights will be flag start.
- 19.2 All riders must be at the start area at least 2 minutes before the start of each event.
- 19.3 Go for Gold – Invitational will only be offered to selected high achieving entrants if time permits. Staggered individual flagged off starts, Handicaps will be an estimate based individual performances throughout the day. Up to a maximum of 1 lap Intervals will be determined by Officials and Starter. Race duration **3 Laps** (single race only).

20 RACING:

- 20.1 Refer to section 8, classes of competition and 11, Race format
- 20.2 Practice and Racing will be conducted in the order by the discretion of the organiser/promoter

Important Information for Junior Riders:

- A rider's age on 1 January will determine his/her age for competition that year. However, a rider may move to the next higher class when he/she becomes eligible to do so during the year, but once a rider moves to the higher age class in any competition, he/she may not go back to the lower age class. Points earned in a lower age class will not transfer to the higher class. This rule will apply to all riders up to and including 16 years old.
- If you start in an age group at the beginning of the series and if you move up into the next age group during the year, you cannot drop back and finish the series.
- Logbooks – All junior riders **MUST** hand their Log Book in at Sign On.

21 NOISE:

- 21.1 As per 2017MOMS – no exceptions.
- 21.2 Competitors **may** be required to undergo a static noise test before commencing practice and/or before or during the competition event.
- 21.3 Machines not complying within the limits as noted in the GCR's will be excluded from taking part in any further practice or competition.

22. GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$75.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

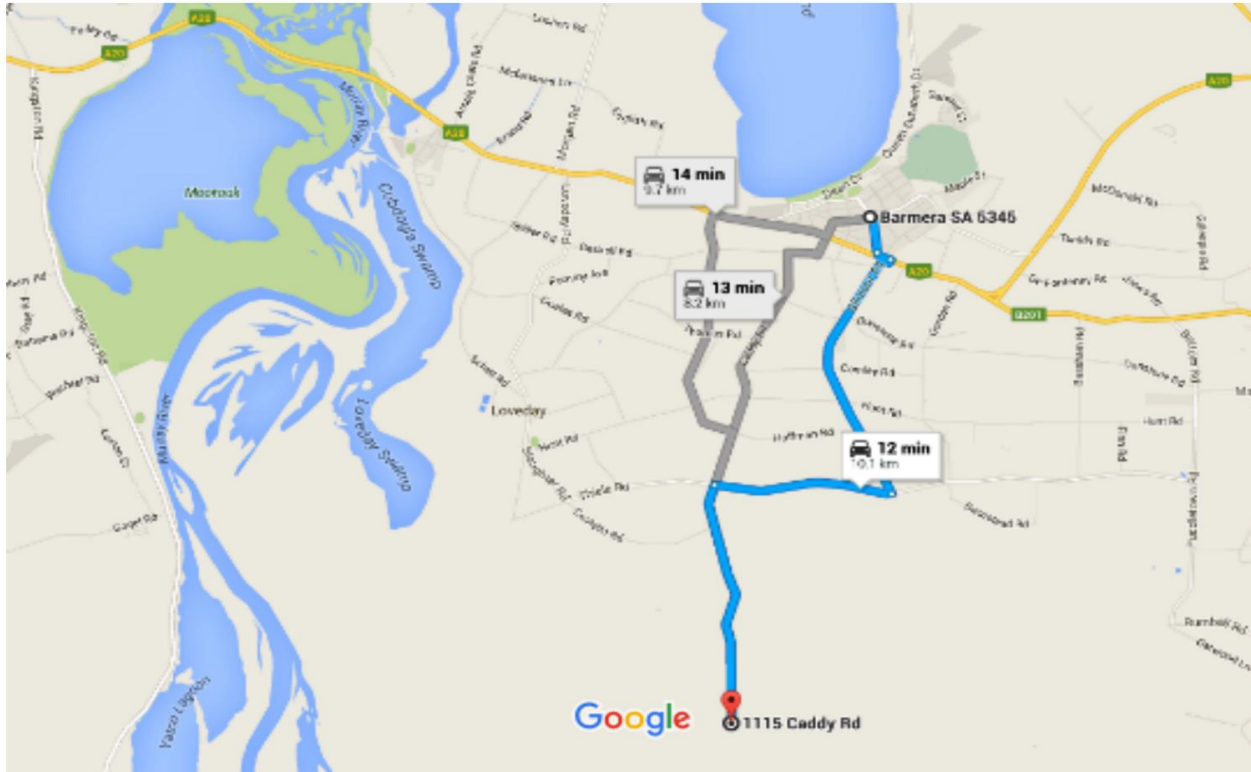
23. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 23.1 Presentations will be held as soon as practicable after racing finishes on Saturday
- 23.2 **Impressive Food** services open from 7am until 8pm **Licensed Bar** 9am until 12pm
- 23.3 Camping available, Friday, Saturday & Sunday Night
- 23.4 Toilet facilities provided.
- 23.6 Shower facilities available at venue, Limited.(Gold Coin Donation)
- 23.7 Admission for Entrants, Pit crew & Spectators \$20 per person over 14 years of age, on arrival
- 23.8 Helmets must be worn on machines at all times, this includes unloading, loading, scrutineering etc. - **\$50.00 fine may be imposed**
- 23.9 Riding in pits **MUST** be walking pace or slower. Any rider disobeying this warning may be excluded from taking any further part in the event - **\$50.00 fine may be imposed**
- 23.10 NO ALCOHOL and NO SMOKING in pit area
- 23.11 Closed shoes to be worn in pit area
- 23.12 Dumping of fuel or oils on the grounds strictly prohibited, drums for waste fuel/oil will be provided.
- 23.13 No dogs allowed (except guide dogs)
- 23.14 Fuel testing may be carried out at any time during event

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

DEFINITIONS

2. In this declaration:

- a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

3. I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
 - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE Australian Consumer and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic)

Under the provisions of the Australian Consumer and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 22N of the Australian Consumer and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic) the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic) if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

6. The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.
7. A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

MEDICAL

8. I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.
9. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

10. MA, my SCB use and disclose personal information for the purposes of conducting and administering Motorcycling Activities and other related activities, including for identifying participants, recording results and providing member services or promotional material. MA collects, uses and discloses personal information in accordance with its privacy policy. MA may share your information with third parties as required by law, and including but not limited to disclosing your personal information for the purpose of administering Motorcycling Activities. The MA privacy policy contains information about how to access and correct personal information held by MA or how to make a complaint. Applications or services may be rejected if requested information is not provided. In certain circumstances, your information may be disclosed overseas, for example, to FIM. Contact information and a copy of MA's privacy policy is available on our website at www.ma.org.au.

PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

11. I hereby agree with MA and the SCB that in consideration for my participation in the Event that MA and the SCB may receive, collect, store and use personal health information about me in the manner set out below:

a) I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- i) If I am injured, become ill or die at or following the Event the party listed at Item 8 in Schedule 1 in addition to any hospital at which I am treated (together "my Carers") will have health related information about me in their possession, power and control relating to me which is subject to obligations imposed by the Privacy Act ("my Information") and the Privacy Act is intended to protect my personal information;
- ii) MA and my SCB wish to collect my Information for purposes that include their risk management programs, evaluating and improving the safety of MA and SCB events and of the Meeting organisers and facility providers of MA / SCB permitted events, and generally to reduce the risks to persons engaged in motorcycle sport; and
- iii) It is reasonable for MA and my SCB to collect, store, use and disclose my Information in accordance with clause 11(a)(i) above and in the manner set out in clause 11(b).

c) I irrevocably authorise MA and my SCB and hereby appoint MA and my SCB as my lawful attorneys to collect from my Carers, and I hereby direct my Carers to provide to MA or my SCB upon request being made by MA or my SCB, any of my Information including but not limited to any information concerning any incident or event causing or contributing to or resulting from any injury, illness or death to me, the details of any diagnosis and prognosis provided to me by my Carers (or any party with the knowledge of any of my Carers), and any other matter to the knowledge of my Carers that might reasonably be considered to be requested by MA or my SCB for the purpose of improving safety at MA and SCB events.

POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

12. I acknowledge, understand and agree that it is a condition of my participation in the Event that I agree to be bound by, and subject to, the rules, regulations and jurisdiction of MA as amended from time to time. Copies of all MA rules, policies and regulations are available by contacting the MA office.

13. All participants are bound by the MA anti doping policy and thus understand they may be subject to drug testing. Testing conducted by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) is in accordance with the ASADA Act and the National Ant-Doping Scheme. This involves the taking of a sample (any human biological fluid or tissue whether alive or otherwise, or any human breath) for the purpose of detecting the use of a Prohibited Drug or Doping Method. Any participant infringing MA's policy or refusing a drug test may be disqualified or otherwise dealt with in accordance with the terms of the anti-doping policy.
