Entries close Thursday 5pm prior to the event.

### **CLASSES OF COMPETITION**

Senior ATV & Solo Ironman and Senior ATV & Solo Teams combined for racing (an ATV and a Solo may Team together)  
Junior 1 ATV Ironkid 90-110 limited(7-11 yrs), Junior 2 ATV Ironkid 90-125 comp(8-12yrs) combined for racing.

Note: Junior 13-16yrs, ATV 200/250cc, Solo 125/150cc and over will wear **Yellow vests** and share the track in Senior racing (Riders Briefing info to contain: **Yellow vest** riders have right of way at all times, being overtaken, or overtaking, all Senior riders must yield and no racing pressure from Senior riders to Juniors will be tolerated. Safe and easy overtaking only).

## **AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:**

A presentation announcement will be made for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> for Junior Ironkid, and Senior Teams and Senior Ironman. Points will be tallied at the end of the Quadriders SA Competition Series and trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for competition classes with adequate entries.

## **ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**

To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be five (5) per class. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events, alter event durations and re-distribute any awards, points and / or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the Event Organiser and/or Event Referee.

## **RACE FORMAT:**

This event will be 3 hours in total for seniors and 1.5 hours for Junior Ironkid class/es Saturday only, and with a free riding opportunity on Sunday.

A sighting lap will be available prior to race start and is highly recommended but non compulsory. Junior Ironkid classes will be sent off individually at intervals of no less than 15 seconds, and no more than 1 minute between riders. Senior Quads & Solos will be sent off individually at intervals of no less than 15 seconds, and no more than 1 minute between riders.

## **MACHINES AND RIDERS:**

All machines entered must comply Quadriders SA 'Racing Rules' and may be inspected prior to the race by a person appointed by the 'Event Referee'.

Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

Changes of machine is permitted providing the substitute machine has been approved by the 'Event Referee'..

Riders must display numberplates on their machine, and all riders must have clearly visible numbers on his or her back.

## **GRID POSITIONS:**

Starting order will be determined by the Event Organiser and/or Event Referee (no argument).

## **RIDERS' BRIEFING:**

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of each race, which ALL competitors MUST attend.

**Camp ground available Friday and Saturday night. Please Camp over and stay and relax.  
Toilet on site, BYO everything else, and take your rubbish with you.**

### **CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:**

The track is being run on private property with hills, rocks, bushland and some creek crossings. The entire track will be clearly marked with arrows and bunting. Please stay on the track for the entirety of the event. Parts of track are close to the farmers crops and we need to stay off the crops.

### **DRUGS AND ALCOHOL:**

Any competitor suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol may be removed/disqualified from the event at the discretion of the 'Event Referee'.

### **CODE OF CONDUCT:**

Any competitors, officials or parents are reminded that this is a family event. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.

### **STARTS:**

Official controlled starts. One rider at a time. Time interval between riders to be communicated at riders briefing.

### **PRACTICE:**

All senior riders will have 1 optional lead sighting lap at non-competitive pace, no overtaking allowed. Sighting lap is compulsory for all juniors.

The race will be a 3 hour timed event for seniors and 1.5 hours for Junior Ironkid, with all riders times being corrected to allow for full race duration. Riders will be flagged in after their time has concluded.

### **SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:**

- NO tear offs are allowed in any events.
- Course cutting, or riding on the farmers cropped areas will result in rider disqualification.
- All 'in race' refueling must be done within the designated refueling zone only.  
The engine must be switched off and rider off the machine.  
Teams refueling (rested engine) and repairs are allowed in the pits.
- Riding in the pits must be at **walking pace**. Penalties will apply to competitors.
- Helmets must be worn at all times whilst on any motorcycle. This includes unloading, loading.
- Closed shoes must be worn in the pit at all times.
- NO CANTEEN AVAILABLE

**No Hassle Policy:** Any rider, entrant or person associated with a rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner in any dealings whatsoever, with any official of the meeting. A rider shall be responsible for his/her own conduct and that of any person with whom he/she is associated who abuses or threatens in any manner, either verbally or physically, any official.

**Abandonment:** In the event of the meeting being abandoned due to circumstances beyond the control of the promoters before racing commences, entry fees will be returned. Once the competition has commenced only the 'Event Referee' has the authority to abandon the meeting and their decision shall be final. In such cases the referee will rule on the results according to the circumstances.

**Reservations:** The 'Event Referee' reserves the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the events program.

Persons are prohibited from entering the track infield area. Such unauthorized persons will be removed from prohibited areas.
